# ORANGE BUOYS ON THE LAKE...




mark rock hazards. Please give all buoys a wide berth to avoid hitting a submerged rock resulting in damage to your boat. A CLOA Boating map showing marked rock locations is available on the CLOA website at <a href="mailto:cloa.org/boat-registration">cloa.org/boat-registration</a>. No wake buoys indicate areas of the lake that require that all powerboats to travel at reduced speed. These areas are located in the southwest and northeast coves.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL NEWS**

Keeping our lake clean is a top priority, and one of the ways we do this is to treat the lake for invasive weeds. The association spent over \$27,000 on weed treatment in 2023! Our lake is shallow and has ideal conditions for lake weeds to flourish. Treating early in the growth cycle reduces the amount of decomposing vegetation, thereby improving water quality. We generally treat in late spring for Curlyleaf Pondweed, and then in early summer for Vallisneria (tape grass) and American Pondweed. The herbicides used have minimal environmental impact, the primary one being a restriction for watering lawns.

Please note that if lake members use their boats in other places, they must clean the hull and intakes so as not to introduce any other weed species (or even zebra mussels).



Another activity conducted on the lake is weekly water testing between June through August. Water samples are taken in the four corners of the lake and year-over-year results have been very good. The state restricts swimming for E.coli at 250 parts per million, and our highest reading was only a 23 in one location this year.

## ICE FISHING SAFETY

## **BEFORE YOU GO**

BRING:

ICE PICKS to grip the ice



WARM CLOTHES

THROW ROPE be prepared



EMPTY BUCKET to sit on



BRING A FRIEND for company & safety



TELL SOMEONE where you are

## ON THE ICE

CHECK ICE THICKNESS at least 4 to 6 in.



CLEAR ICE is stronger than cloudy ice AVOID open water



LOOK FOR HOLES drilled by others (and don't step in one) AVOID pressure ridges



SPREAD OUT if you have a big group









We continue to enjoy a great safety record here on Cedar Lake! It is crucial for us to remember that an injury on our lake could impact our ability to be able to be insured. If that were to happen, it is a real possibility that we would be forced to have a 5 MPH limit or even a 5hp limit. It is imperative that we stay safe.

Please bear in mind that each member and their guests are responsible for their own safety. Use of the lake is at your own risk. The Safety Patrol Boat is not always manned and should not be relied upon to police the safety of our, or our guest's use of the lake. State laws apply. It is each member's responsibility to know and follow the boating laws.

Remember to keep 75' from shore when traveling more than 5mph with a power boat, and no swimming more than 75' from shore unless accompanied by a boat.





All people being towed by a boat or using a stand-up paddle board have to, by state law, be wearing a PFD.





All boats must have a PFD for everyone on board including kayaks, other small boats and SUP's. Children under 12 must wear a PFD at all times. STATE LAW SAYS ALL PERSONS IN A SMALL BOAT MUST WEAR A PFD BETWEEN OCT 1-MAY 31. All boats towing a person must have a designated spotter.

#### 2024 CLOA ANNUAL DUES

The CLOA Annual Dues for 2024 for each membership property are \$650.00. Payment is due within 90 days from January 1, 2024. Payment received after March 31<sup>st</sup> is subject to a \$50.00 late fee and monthly interest penalties.

All CLOA members are requested to provide a copy of their homeowner's insurance policy. This is to ensure that all members have liability insurance coverage, which is generally a part of a homeowner's insurance policy, to protect you for any liability arising as a result of any activities at your lakefront and in/on Cedar Lake where harm comes to you, your family or your guests.

**Please provide a copy of your homeowner's policy with your Annual Dues payment**. Note: The insurance requirements for registering powered boats in the spring, will remain the same.

Detach the dues form below and include it with your payment of \$650.00 for each member property, and a copy of your homeowner insurance. Please provide an email address to assist us in establishing a contact list for our membership. Important CLOA information including the Newsletter will be emailed to members whenever possible.

By remitting payment of 2024 dues, the member acknowledges and agrees to comply and have their family and guests comply with the By-laws of Cedar Lake Owners Association, Inc., its rules and regulations, and the State of Connecticut boating laws and regulations when accessing/swimming, operating any boat, motorboat, other watercraft and/or any manually propelled vessel on Cedar Swamp Pond aka Cedar Lake, and at all times exhibits safe boating/water recreation practices, and further acknowledges that all such activities are at the individuals' owns risk.
